1. The WhatNext.Law Best Thesis Award will be awarded to the best master thesis in any of the subjects in which WhatNext.Law conducts innovative research on, including but not limited to the following:

2. Applicants must have successfully defended their thesis between September 1 2024 and September 15 2026.
3. Submissions must include:
 - a. the thesis for submission in both Word and PDF format (or equivalent);
 - b. an WhatNext.law Insight, an online short-form blog post presenting and reviewing the thesis (its topic, arguments and conclusions) which uses the WhatNext.law template and adheres to the WhatNext.law insight guidelines;
 - c. master's degree certificate.

By submitting their thesis and insight, applicants acknowledge their acceptance of WhatNext.Law Best Thesis Award Regulation and this Call for Submissions.

4. Applications should be sent to info@whatnext.law until the 23h59 of September 15 2026.
5. Results will be communicated to the participants until October 15 2026. The Jury reserves the right to delay the decision to award a winner if necessary.
